

Did you know?


7.8% children in the North Locality aged O-15 live in absolute poverty compared to 27.6% across the city (3)

The most deprived ward (5/69) is Castle Vale. The least deprived (44/69) ward is Erdington (3)

12.8% children aged 4-5 in Castle Vale ward were classed as obese compared to 11% across the city (3)









