

Did you know?


The most deprived ward (3/69) is Sparkbrook and Balsall Heath East. The least deprived ward is Hall Green South 61/69 (3)

14.9% children aged 4-5 in the Sparkbrook and Balsall Heath East ward were classed as obese compared to 11% across the city (3)






